

From the Parochial Church Council (June 2014)

The Council recently approved the annual report and financial statement, a copy of which is on the Church and Village noticeboards. On the financial front total receipts in 2013 were £7319 of which £439 were restricted donations for the Church Fabric Fund. Total expenses were £9981, leaving a deficit of £2367. This deficit was covered by a transfer of funds from our fabric Fund as essential work had to be done to the mediaeval tower staircase in order to allow access for future urgent repair work on the church tower.

We raised £1330 from our fundraising activities of which 10% was donated to the East Anglian Air Ambulance and the greater part of the balance of receipts were donated by a core of 7 benefactors. Our Income, which dropped by 16% over the last year, is essential to ensure we keep this historic Church open for future generations and as a vital village asset. To do this we will need the support of the whole community.
